



Footwear – Some Guidance for Staff, Parents and Students at Haydock High School

In the modern era, it can be difficult to identify what are ‘trainers’ and what are ‘shoes’. To help with this we have included below a reference to help.

At Haydock, we define school shoes as being all black, leather, flat soled and suitable for wear with trousers or skirts. They should be practical too, and stand up to the ‘wear and tear’ of school life.

If you were to buy ‘school shoes’ from some shops, they might look like this:



These are all black, leather, flat soled and suitable for wearing with trousers or skirts.

- ✓ These can be worn to Haydock High School.

Some other shoes look like this:



These are all black, leather, flat soled and suitable for wearing with trousers or skirts.

- ✓ These can be worn to Haydock High School.

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Some of our students are wearing footwear like this:



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These have built-up ‘athletic’ soles, are canvas, are not all black, are unsuitable to be worn with trousers or skirts and **cannot be worn to Haydock High School.**
